



CALL FOR VOLUNTEER CLFN CHILD WELFARE ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPLICATIONS

Cold Lake First Nation (CLFN) is currently seeking applications from individuals who are willing to commit to the responsibilities of being a member of the volunteer CLFN child welfare advisory committee.

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

1. Working collaboratively with the CLFN Band Designate to deliver advocacy to all CLFN children and families who have involvement with provincial offices of Children & Family Services.
2. Willing to meet on a quarterly basis to complete reviews of all active CFS cases.
3. Assist in promotion of creating new foster and kinship homes on Cold Lake First Nations.
4. Regular and consistent attendance at and participation in all meeting of the Advisory Committee.
5. Assist with keeping cultural connections between children in care and traditional values and beliefs of Cold Lake First Nations.

Applicants must satisfy the following criteria in order to be eligible to hold a position on the Board of Directors:

1. Must be a member of Cold Lake First Nation and at least 18 years of age.
2. Must be knowledgeable in the Child Youth and Family Enhancement Act.
3. Must be committed to acting in the best interest of the all CLFN children and families.
4. Must be committed to regular attendance at all Committee meeting's.
5. Must support the mission, vision, values and goals of Cold Lake First Nations.
6. Must complete and submit a recent criminal record check (vulnerable sector) and a child intervention record check.
7. Must be willing to sign a Child Family Services (CFS) Oath of Confidentiality.
8. The Advisory Committee will ideally consist of a combination of male and females, an elder and individuals with experience and knowledge in the field.
