**Cold Lake First Nations (CLFN) launches Electoral Reform Commission**  
**SECOND CALL**  
**Accepting Applications for three (3) Advisors**

May 29, 2017, (Cold Lake First Nation, Treaty 6 Territory, Alberta) – Cold Lake First Nations launched an Electoral Reform Commission with a mandate to develop a new Election Law and hold a referendum to approve it by December 2017. CLFN has extended a second call for applications for one Elder advisor, two Youth advisors. All submissions must be received by the CLFN Administration by close of business on July 31, 2017.

Today, Cold Lake First Nations is pleased to announce the launch of our “**Denezi nalts'ı Commission / Electoral Reform Commission**” said Chief Bernice Martial.

“The Electoral Reform Commission will operate at arms length from Chief and Council to implement the Terms of Reference for the Commission. This will ensure political neutrality and professional service in the best interest of all citizens of Cold Lake First Nations and for the community’s well-being.
