**Cold Lake First Nations (CLFN) launches Electoral Reform Commission
SECOND CALL
Accepting Applications for one (1) Advisor**

May 29, 2017, (Cold Lake First Nation, Treaty 6 Territory, Alberta) – Cold Lake First Nations launched an Electoral Reform Commission with a mandate to develop a new Election Law and hold a referendum to approve it by July 2018. CLFN has extended a second call for applications for one (1) off-reserve resident advisor. Please submit a letter of intent along with your resume to apply for these positions to the Band Administrator at ceo@clfn.com. All submissions must be received by the CLFN Administration by close of business on October 20, 2017.

“Cold Lake First Nations is concerned with the number and nature of Election appeals that have been made to the Electoral Officer, the Appeals Committee and to the Federal Court of Canada in recent years. Today, Cold Lake First Nations is pleased to announce the launch of our “**Denezi nalts’i Commission / Electoral Reform Commission**” said Chief Bernice Martial.

“The Electoral Reform Commission will operate at arms length from Chief and Council to implement the Terms of Reference for the Commission. This will ensure political neutrality and professional service in the best interest of all citizens of Cold Lake First Nations and for the community’s well-being. All CLFN citizens are encouraged to participate in the activities of the Commission,” added Chief Martial.
